34 Cellulitis (inflammation and infection of the skin and subcutaneous tissue most commonly due to streptococci or staphylococci) around ulcer should be treated with systemic gram-positive bactericidal antibiotics 35 Minimize the tissue level of bacteria, preferably to $\leq 10^5$ CFU/g of tissue, with no beta hemolytic streptococci in the
