◆ Consider the risk of QT prolongation when starting a new medicine ◆ Assess the patient's risk factors for QT prolongation ◆ Avoid QT prolonging drugs in patients with congenital long QT syndrome ◆ Correct any modifiable risk factors such as electrolyte disturbance

QTc: how long is too long?

The QT interval is defined as the time duration between the onset of the QRS complex and the end of the T wave as it returns to baseline (fig 2), ideally measured using either lead II or lead V5 of the 12-lead ECG There are no standards for interpreting prolonged QT intervals from Holter or 24/48 h

a QT prolonging drug • Current use of any non-cardiac QT prolonging drug was associated with a significantly increased risk of SCD (adjusted OR 27) • The highest risk was associated with antipsychotic drugs (adjusted OR 50) • The risk was higher in women ...

warnings relating to drug-induced QT prolongation for three commonly used drugs - citalopram, domperidone and ondansetron^{1,2,3} Extra vigilance is required by healthcare professionals to be alert to the risk of drug induced QT prolongation and drug interactions There are three mechanisms by which drugs can interact

Guidelines on Choice and Selection of Antidepressants for ...

Citalopram: QT interval prolongation—new maximum daily dose restrictions (including in elderly patients), contraindications, and warnings Citalopram most toxic of SSRI's in overdose (coma, seizures, arrhythmia)⁵ Contraindicated with other QT prolonging medications Baseline ECG advised in patients with cardiac disease

Prescribing information for high-dose fexofenadine in the ...

in the plasma concentrations of fexofenadine, though this was not accompanied by any effects on the QT interval or any increase in adverse events compared to monotherapy Administration of antacid containing aluminium or magnesium hydroxide gels 15 minutes prior to fexofenadine

Although QT prolongation is not a perfect marker of arrhythmia risk, this has become a primary safety metric among oncologists Cardiologists caring for patients receiving cancer treatment should become familiar with the drugs associated with QT prolongation, its incidence, and appropriate management strategies to provide

should be given to dose reduction of QT prolonging drugs or changing to an alternative non QT prolonging drug Prolonged QTc Interval >500 ms in males and females A QTc interval >500 ms is clinically significant and likely to confer an increased risk of arrhythmia Any drugs which prolong the QT interval should be reviewed immediately 6,8,9,10

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Scottish Palliative Care Guidelines

- Second line - †QT levomepromazine 3mg to 6mg twice daily orally or 25 mg to 5mg by subcutaneous injection 12 hourly as needed or 5mg to 15mg in 24 hours by continuous subcutaneous infusion May need to give subcutaneous injection more frequently initially, for example hourly, to control symptoms •
